STARTING TIME STRUCTURE

If the field size is 104 - 112, the starting times will be as follows: Foursomes / Double Tee / Single Wave

7:30 - 9:40 every 10 minutes utilizing #1 / #10 on both Wanamaker / Dye

7:30 - 9:40 every 10 minutes utilizing #1 tee on the Ryder

7:45 - 9:55 every 10 minutes utilizing #11 tee on the Ryder

If the field size is 113 - 120, the starting times will be as follows: Threesomes / Double Tee / Double Wave

7:30 - 9:00 every 9 minutes utilizing #1 / #10 on ALL courses (Wanamaker / Dye / Ryder)

11:30 - 1:00 every 9 minutes utilizing #1 / #10 on ALL courses (Wanamaker / Dye / Ryder)

WEATHER DELAYS / SUSPENSION / CANCELLATION OF ROUNDS

Every effort will be made to finish each round as scheduled. If unplayable conditions occur, play would be suspended and resumed as soon as conditions allow.

Please note the following scenarios that could occur:

1. The first round is suspended and cannot be completed the first day. The first round would be completed the next day and we would try to complete the second round that same day.
2. If the second round is suspended and cannot be completed that day, every effort would be made to finish the following day. Many factors would have to be evaluated, the most important being the availability of the golf course. If the second round cannot be completed, it will be canceled and the prize money will be paid in full based on first round scores.
3. In the event that none of the rounds can be completed, full refunds will be given to each contestant.

The Tournament Director has the final decision on all matters relating to any suspension or cancellation

WITHDRAWALS / NO SHOWS

With the popularity of the Tournament Series and having a large wait list, we will be implementing a new NO CARD / NO SHOW policy for the 2021 Series.

1. If a player "NO CARD's" during Round One or "NO SHOW's" for Round Two, without a legitimate excuse, and the Tournament Series Event is full WITH a wait list, the player, if participating in the next event, will be removed from the event and the wait list will be used to fill the field.
2. If the player is NOT registered in the next event, he / she will be removed from the next event, in which, he / she is registered for their NO CARD or NO SHOW.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

This application is subject to acceptance by PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc., in its sole discretion. Applicant agrees, that in the event of acceptance of the application, the application and Applicant's participation in the event may be rejected or revoked at any time thereafter for violation of eligibility criteria or any conditions of entry.

Both the application and Applicant's participation in the event are subject to all Rules, Regulations, provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Professional Golfers' Association of America and other conditions applicable to the Championship, as well as the terms and conditions of any contract with PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc., may have made with other parties with respect to same, inclusive of, but not limited to, anti-doping policies.

Applicant expressly releases and discharges The PGA of America, PGA Tournament Corporation, Inc., its affiliates and subsidiaries, officers, directors, employees, members, sponsors, and host sites from and against any claim of injury in any way attributable to or incidental to participation in the 2021 PGA Tournament Series, and acknowledges that applicant expressly assumes the risk and danger incidental to participation in the event, inclusive of, but not limited to, injuries caused by errant golf shots, injuries sustained attributable to weather conditions, or injuries attributable to the golf course or host site's premises. Applicant agrees that they choose to participate in the event at their own risk and will assume the risk of injury in association with participating in the event.

Applicant agrees that Applicant will not share in any part of the prize money, which Applicant may win in The PGA Tournament Series with any other contestant.

ELIGIBILITY

PGA Member and Associate Eligibility**

Entry is limited to the first 120 PGA Members and Associates that register for the event prior to the deadline. If entries do not exceed 104 at the time of the deadline the field will be capped at 104. If entries exceed 120 players, the additional entrants will be waitlisted based upon the date and time of entry. All PGA members are eligible (except classes A-3, HM, RM, LMC, Reserve and Class "F" members). Associates registered in the PGA Professional Golf Management Program, are also welcome to enter the PGA Tournament Series events. Neither suspended Members nor suspended Associates are eligible to participate.

****Note 1:** No player (member or associate) will be eligible if he/she has played in **more than eight (8)** combined Adams Pro Tour (APT), Asian Tour, Dakotas Tour, European Challenge Tour, European Senior Tour, European Tour, JPGA Senior Tour, JPGA Tour, Korn Ferry Tour, Ladies European Tour (LET), Symetra Tour (LPGA), LPGA Tour, Mackenzie Tour-Canada (including the Forme Tour), PGA Australia Tours, PGA New Zealand Tours, PGA TOUR, PGA TOUR Champions, PGA TOUR-China, PGA TOUR LatinoAmerica, SwingThought Tour, The Safari Tour and The Sunshine Tour. The U.S. Open, U.S. Senior Open, U.S. Women's Open, PGA Championship, KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship and KPMG Women's PGA Championship are not included in the 8-tournament count.

****Note 2:** Any player earning exempt (only) playing privileges on the PGA, Champions, LPGA, Futures or Korn Ferry TOURS, and has participated in an event that the player gained entry solely through their exempt (only) playing privileges, will be **ineligible** to play in the PGA Tournament Series (or PGA Winter Championships). For clarification, any player who has gained exempt status for these tours will be eligible to participate in the PGA Tournament Series/PGA Winter Championships until the exemption has actually been used to play in a respective "TOUR" event.

LIMITED FIELD

The field will be **limited to a total of 120 players** in each event. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-entered basis. **At the time of Entry Deadline if the field is does not exceed 104 players, the field will be capped at such number (104).**

TOURNAMENT FEES

The entry fee is \$375 which includes course fees for both days, carts, registration, tournament operations and range fees. The entry fee covers practice balls prior to the tournament round each day. Practice rounds will require additional payment made directly to the Golf Shop.

The use of carts is mandatory. Only players are allowed to ride in the cart (no caddies or spectators).

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a, for which the penalty is two (2) strokes for first offense and for subsequent offense – **disqualification.**

ON-SITE CONTESTANT REGISTRATION

There will be NO IN PERSON registration at the 2021 PGA Tournament Series.

SPONSOR DOLLARS ADDED TO THE PURSE

A total of **\$11,500** sponsor dollars will be added to each event's purse.

ENTRY DEADLINE

The entry deadline is 5:00 p.m. EST, approximately **two weeks prior** to each event. **Deadlines for both events #3 & #4 will be on Monday, November 22 at 5:00 PM EST due to the Thanksgiving Holiday.**

TOURNAMENT WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS

Withdrawals may be made on or prior to an entry deadline without a doctor's certificate and will be fully refunded, minus a withdrawal fee of \$25.

Partial Refund (for any withdrawal after entry deadline):

A written (and acceptable) doctor's excuse must be presented for consideration of a partial refund. Unacceptable excuses would be chronic and recurring injuries, such as sore wrists, back, etc. A partial refund is defined as \$125.

SHOES WITH METAL SPIKES PROHIBITED

Shoes with traditional metal spikes are prohibited in these events. Penalty for breach of this condition is **Disqualification**.

PRIZE MONEY DISTRIBUTION
