The rotation of this alternate list goes into effect on **Tuesday, October 10, 2023, at 7:00 a.m. ET**. Until this time, if a non-exempt player withdraws from your Section, we will go to your Section's alternate list to replace them. After this time, we will consult the National Alternate List solely (above) for the replacement player, regardless of how the player withdrawing secured a spot in the field. If an EXEMPT player withdraws at any time, or if a section exhausts their respective alternate list, we will consult the NAL right away. **Only the 1st available alternate** from your Section's list will be offered an NAL spot, and if declined, the next Section's 1st available alternate will be offered the spot.
